At the meeting on Tuesday afternoon, details were finalised about the building work which is taking place over the summer holidays. The school carpark will be closed on Wednesday and access to the school will be through the hall side entrance. The kitchen will be emptied on Friday morning so the hall will be out of action all day. Children on school dinners will receive a packed lunch made by school. For health and safety reasons, the following will take place from Wednesday:

Barriers will be erected and the school carpark will be out of bounds for everyone. Pupils will enter and exit school via the hall side door, and staff will be on hand to try to make this as smooth as possible. This does mean that there will be a lot of children passing through these doors at the beginning and end of the school day. We are therefore suggesting that parents of pupils in Reception and KS1 **only** can collect their children between 3.05pm – 3.15pm if they wish to. Parents who have children in **both** key stages should wait until between 3.30pm – 3.40pm to collect their children.
