The children have loved exploring the snow this week. We had a snowy Welly Walk Wednesday, we made snowmen, snowballs and enjoyed running around in the snow. I have added some photos to the Little Bells facebook page.

We have been reading the story, The Three Little Pigs and we have linked this to science and explored materials talking about which material is the strongest and which material we would use to build a house. The children then made a junk model house and added windows, doors and chimneys. We felt straw, sticks and bricks and listed the features.

In maths we learning about what number comes next, this is tricky for some children but we are improving every day. You can practice this at home.

In phonics we have learnt the g sound (round the girls face, down her hair and give her a curl) We have listed the words we can think of beginning with a g and added to the over the week.

In PE we have continued to add new apparatus and built upon the children's safety knowledge of how to use the apparatus safely.

Next week we are moving on to, Goldilocks and the Three Bears. The children will be making their own porridge and looking at size in Maths.
