This week we have focused on Design and Technology, the children have designed a superhero sock puppet on a template, then made their design using a variety of resources and material. We had some amazing superheroes and the children used some fabulous vocabulary to describe their puppet. We have used the puppets during role play and the children have made their own stories up.

On Monday the whole school took part in an RE day focused on Hinduism. The children talked about special clothes that they wear and we looked at traditional Hindu clothing and talked about the bright colours. This led nicely into the afternoon activity, we talked about the Holi festival which is a Hindu Spring festival, otherwise known as the festival of colours. The children mixed colours by blowing paint using a straw on an elephant template. We talked about what colours we mixed and what colours we created.

Today we have focused on Art - the children have explored Rangoli patterns and then created their own pattern on a piece of bunting, which will be joined together and displayed in the hall.

Next week we are moving on the Supertato, stories by Sue Hendra and Paul Linnet. This links to our topic Superheroes and we have lots of fun activities planned!
