We have played with Mr Potato Head and then cut pieces out to work on our fine motor skills and stick them on the potato. We had fun designing some funny faces which promoted good speech and language.

In Maths we have counted potatoes and matched them to the correct number to help with number recognition.

In phonics the children have been split into different groups; this will enable us to really focus on giving the children lots of support in the last term before going to reception class.

We have had a student, Miss Harrison in Little Bells on a Tuesday for the last term, she has built some lovely relationships with the children. She is now on the next part of her placement so will be in full time for the next six weeks.
