We have had a fabulous week in Little Bells, we have met all the new starters who will be joining Little Bells after the Easter break. This week has been extremely busy learning about Spring. The children have created flowers, bees, butterflies and trees. We have learnt about the Life Cycle of a Butterfly and linked this to the Hungry Caterpillar story. The children have then sequenced the cycle. On Tuesday the children made chicks using feathers, eyes and pipe cleaners, they are hung in the role play area.

Our topic next term is animals; dinosaurs, sea animals, zoo animals, farm animals ending with mini-beasts. We have arranged a trip to Mrs Brown's farm and will send home more information after the holidays.

In phonics the children in the apple group have learnt the c, k, ck and e sound. The pears have moved on to the m sound and the bananas are re-capping s a t p i n sounds.

In maths we have continued with our number recognition and all the children are doing amazing and blowing my socks off with how many numbers they recognise. Well done Little Bells.
