This week for topic work we have looked at zoo and jungle animals, we have read lots of animal stories and recapped the structure of a story. We have looked at how animals move and the different characteristics of each animal. All the children have completed their dinosaur prints using clay and painted them to take home this week.

Next week we are moving on to under the sea and looking at which animals live in the ocean. We are going to make fish then race them using straws.

In maths we have continued with our number work, exploring numbers in lots of different ways to understand different concepts of making a total number. For example the children have thought about what groups of numbers make 5 in total. (1 and 4, 3 and 2)
