What wonderful weather we have had this week, with the lovely sunshine! Lots of outdoor learning has taken place, which has linked nicely to our topic work this week; Under the Sea. The children have all made a fish that we raced during our welly walk. We have also been learning about the number 8 and linked this to an octopus then made an octopus. We have looked at facts about a variety of creatures that live under the sea.

In PSED (Personal, social, emotional development) we have been talking about how to be a good friend, we have talked about saying nice things to our friends and how that makes us feel. We have also linked this to working as a team and played some team games.

In phonics the apples have learnt the r sound and practiced forming the letter r. The pears have been working hard writing their name independently and the bananas have been playing games using s a t p i n sounds.

In maths we have been counting under the sea creatures and grouping them in different ways. We have counted items outside and continued with our number recognition.

In Literacy we have been exploring the book, Tiddler by Julia Donaldson. The children have talked about what they can see on each page and this was linked to being a good friend.
