We are already in July, the last few weeks of the summer term. This week we have started to practice the graduation. All the children have been learning a rhyme with actions that they have devised as a group. We have been practicing the songs we will be singing and a few children have started to learn some words to say. The graduation is for the children who move into reception in September. This week some of the children have been talking about the new movie; Toy Story 4. The children have all made a "Forkie." They designed it on paper then made it using a variety of resources.

In Maths we have been looking at shapes and finding them in the environment. We have been learning about the properties of each shape and linking our learning to everyday items.
