Today we have been designing pictures using circles and the children have created some amazing pictures of teddy bears. In the afternoon as part of our golden time the children have decorated biscuits using icing pens this helps develop our fine motor skills ready for writing.

In Maths we are focusing on a number each week, this week has been all about the number 1. The children have practiced forming the numeral, searched for number 1's in the environment and on Thursday we carried out a number hunt in the outside area.

In Literacy we have been reading the story "The Monkey Who Didn't Listen." We shared our thoughts on how to be a good listener. This linked to our Welly Walk Wednesday activity. The children made a paper bag and decorated it, then collected sounds outside by drawing what they could hear.

In phonics we have played lots of sound games and used the musical instruments. We have been reading rhyming stories and singing nursery rhymes.

The weather has been lovely this week with lots of sunshine, which has meant we have had lots of outdoor learning and the children have had chance to use the big parachute which was exciting running under it, while it was in the air.
