Our maths this week has been all about the number 4, our shape of the week is a square. The children have learnt how to make number 4, What 4 pence looks like, we have looked at the number 4 numicon and practiced forming the numeral.

In art we have looked at the artist Piet Mondrian, he created art work using squares and with a limited amount of colours, I have put a link on the Facebook page. The children decided on their own colours and sizes of squares to use in their creations.

In Literacy we have been reading lots of Mr Men and Little Miss Stories the children painted their own Mr Men character talking about different emotions.

In phonics we have learnt the sounds; s a t p and next week we will learn I and n and play lots of games using these sounds to build knowledge.

For welly walk we played the Mr Men game moving in a variety of ways; Mr Slow, Mr Rush, Mr Tall, Mr Small, Mr Wobble and Mr Muddle, walking backwards which was fun!

We have two students with us in Little Bells for a four-week placement; Mrs Ismail and Miss Zahran. They are both in their final year at Edgehill University and have lots of early years' experience. The children have enjoyed getting to know them this week and loved having extra adults to explore the classroom with.
