This week in maths we have looked at the number 9 and number bonds to 9. The rhyme the children have learnt is; draws a circle add a line now I've made a number 9. In reception we have looked at addition and why we add two numbers together. The children have practiced number formation using all the numbers we have learnt so far. If you could continue to practice at home that would be marvellous.

In Literacy we have been looking at rhymes and poems and picking out rhyming words, then started to create our own rhymes using picture cards. The children are working extremely hard in phonics and have blown my socks off this week, well done everyone!

Our theme this week has been birthdays as part of our celebration topic. We celebrated Mrs Potter's birthday on Wednesday and the children all designed their own cakes and added candles. We have practiced the months of the year and the children have tried to remember when their birthday is, which was quite tricky! During carpet time we looked at how different countries celebrate birthdays and discussed how we celebrate.

Welly walk Wednesday was a present hunt outside, the children had to find 20 presents with numbers on then put the numbers in order working as a team.

Next week we are looking at weddings and christening celebrations then the following week it will be all about Christmas!! I cannot believe it's that time of year again. I will be sending home information about the nativity play next week.
