Discover

Once upon a time...

This term, reception will focus on learning a wide range of skills across the EYFS curriculum. We will be focusing on a different traditional tale each week in the first half term.

In Summer 2 we will be learning about different types of holidays, transport and Summer.

Learning will be based around understanding the world. Children will learn about similarities and differences in relation to places, objects, materials and living things.

Concepts we will be covering:

- Choice
- Change
- Resilience
- Conflict

Authentic outcome:

As well as developing skills, the children will work towards an authentic outcome which is designed to encourage real ownership over learning.

Summer 1 authentic outcome will be for children to create their own story and share it with another class.

Summer 2 authentic outcome will be for the children to create a summer artwork display.

Early Years Wow Events

Summer 1 - A wow morning linked to different traditional tales. Children can dress up as their favourite character.

Summer 2 - role play going on a holiday. Children will bring a suitcase to school and prepare by creating a passport and ticket, ready for the journey!

Prime Areas

Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

Children talk about how they and others show feelings, talk about their own and others' behaviour, consequences and know what behaviour is unacceptable. The concept words we are focusing on for PSED are conflict and resilience.

Physical Development

In PE the children will be learning dance, Coordination in large and small movements safely negotiating space. Welly walks will be discovering environmental changes in summer.

Communication and Language

Children will learn to follow instructions involving several ideas or actions. Children will learn to express themselves effectively. Children use past, present and future forms accurately when talking about events.

Specific Areas

Literacy

Summer 1 - We will focus 6 traditional tales; Goldilocks and the Three Bears, Little Red Riding Hood, Snow White, The Three Pigs, The Elves and the Shoemaker and The Ugly Duckling. In phonics we will be continuing to embed the phase 3 sounds.

Summer 2, for Literacy we will look at the books about Summer, types of holidays, transport and transition to year 1. We will be writing sentences using a capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop.

Maths

Maths this term is focusing on numbers 11 - 20, addition, subtraction, doubling, sharing and grouping. We will be focusing on patterns, length and height.

What will reception discover?

Understanding the world People and communities

Children we learn about past and present events in their own lives and in the lives of family members linked to holidays and transport. For example, what our cars are like now compared to when are grandma's/Grandads were 4 and 5 years old.

The World

Reception will be focusing on similarities and differences in relation to places, objects, materials and living things.

Technology

This term in IT we will be using an application called JIT. The children will learn how to create a scene. In Summer 2 we will use the beebots and the children will have access to eBooks and audio books for guided read.

Creative

Expressive Art and Design

Children will look at past artists compared to modern artists. They will have a go at creating their own pieces of artwork inspired by the style and techniques of these artists.

Exploring using media and materials

Children will be baking this term, safely exploring tools and techniques. Experimenting with different textures.

Being imaginative

Opportunities for being imaginative are encouraged throughout the classroom.

The roles play opportunities are increased in the outdoor area, we include den building, different construction materials. The opportunities are endless; all you need is your imagination.

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
