This term, Year 1 will focus on learning a wide range of skills across the curriculum.


Learning will be based around the history of different events and significant people who have had an effect on life today. We will use the concepts:

- Rights
- Change
- Freedom
- Equality
- Fairness

Authentic outcome:

As well as developing skills, the children will work towards an authentic outcome which is designed to encourage real ownership over learning.

This term, children will be involved in a day in the life of the past focussed on school, they will have a visitor from Mr Ward and an experience of a plane journey!



Core Subjects

English

We will be exploring 'On The Way Home' and the children will be writing their own version. We will recap letters and explore recounts.

Maths

Measurement - length, height, weight and volume.
Number - Multiplication, division and fractions.

Science

Humans: we will look at the human body and label different parts. We will explore senses and look at how we can test different senses.

Animals: we will explore different types of animals and their features and take a virtual (maybe real-life) trip to the zoo!

Rights, Change, Freedom, Equality, Fairness

PSHE

Health and wellbeing: many values are taught within PSHE. We will be focusing on:

- Understanding our feelings
- My strengths and qualities
 - Importance of sleep
 - Relaxation
 - Sun safety and allergies
- People who help us stay healthy

RE

RE at Belthorn explores a variety of religions, beliefs and traditions. Children will have the opportunity to discuss their own and understand other peoples' beliefs. This allows them to gain a better understanding of the world around them and show the importance of acceptance.

RE in Year 1 focuses on:
What do people say about God?

During this term, children will discover:

- Hinduism: their belief in God
 - Christianity: belonging
- Islam: How might beliefs?
- Seekism: How do people find out about God?

What will Year 1 Discover?

History

This term is a history based topic. We will explore what children's lives were like in the past, including houses, schools, technology, toys and rights. They will learn about when the hospital system got introduced and the first plane.

They will:

- Learn about significant events
- Describe changes across time
- Identify similarities and differences between ways of life

Geography

Geography will continue to make use of maps and locate different places around the world. They will explore different features of their environments and what they like.

Computing

Children will continue their Hour of Code and use IT to make examples of their space badges using paint.

Art

Children will look at past artists compared to modern artists. They will have a go at creating their own pieces of artwork inspired by the style and techniques of these artists.

DT

Cooking and nutrition. Children will explore different healthy food items and prepare a healthy meal.

PE

Year 1 will continue to develop their physical skills. We will be focusing on ball skills and gymnastics .
