This week we have been busy looking at the season and the changes in the environment as we move from spring to summer. We discussed ways to keep us safe in the sun and looked at how plants and flowers are changing.

In Literacy the children listened to the story of The Little Sunflower and discussed how to plant sunflower seeds and how to care for them. The children have planted their own sunflower seeds and will care for them over the next six weeks before bringing them home.

In maths we have continued our shape sorting activity and counting to 10 and beyond.

In Mrs Hall's phonics group, we have started blending our sounds together in readiness for reading when the children transition into Reception class in September. A process which we will cover over the next few weeks.

Welly walk this week was an environmental hunt to look at the flowering plants and shrubs we have in school and how they have changed. Followed by a dip in the paddling pool and an ice-lolly, happy days!

This terms topic is 'Summer'. We will be looking at the season, holidays destinations and travel. To introduce our topic, we will be holding one of our WOW events on Wednesday 16th June.
