This is a rare opportunity to join Belthorn Academy Primary School. Staff turnover is very low, which is a reflection on what a wonderful place it is to work.

Belthorn Academy Primary School is an excellent semi-rural community primary school, for ages 3 - 11, with a Pre-School on site, known as 'Little Bells'. All classes provide a high standard of education leading to outstanding SATs results.

You will be joining a friendly, committed team and enjoy opportunities for professional development. Creative, multi-skilled teaching staff are supported by a dedicated team of Teaching Assistants. This vacancy is due to an unexpected long term absence and will be on a temporary basis for 2021/22, initially until March 2022, but may be extended for the full school year.

This post will be focused on working with our Early Years children in our Pre-School, 'Little Bells'. Working with our 3 and 4 year old children you will support early learning and play. An application has also been made to accommodate Rising 3's for 2021/22 and confirmation of this change should be received in September.

Experience of working with these age groups is an advantage, and applications are particularly welcomed from experienced candidates.

Working 37 hours per week from 9.30am to 5.30pm, you will follow established routines in our popular Pre-School. The Pre-School staff work closely with the Reception class to form an early years unit and support each other, under the supervision of the Reception class teacher.

The post is term time only and pro rata which equates to 43.89 to 45.09 paid weeks per year dependent on previous service. Pay is equivalent to £9.81 to £10.21 per hour dependent on experience.
