This week has been super busy! Our first PE lesson was amazing, we completed a yoga session linked to jungle animals. The children practiced moving in different ways and listened carefully to the instructions.

The children have created a 'Who lives in my house' picture which encourages communication and language and is lovely because we get to know a little bit more about each child.

On Welly Walk Wednesday we went on a sound walk, listening to sounds in the environment, this is part of phase 1 phonics to improve our listening skills. We shared a story about the monkey who learnt to listen and the children all made some ears.

In maths we will focus on a number each week, this week it was zero, we shared the story; Zero the Hero and practiced showing zero.

In Literacy we read the story, Elmer by David McKee. The children talked about all the different elephants and how we are all different. We celebrated our differences. The children made an Elmer picture, tearing and sticking coloured tissue paper onto an elephant. We talked about our favourite colours.

On Friday for Golden Time, the children discussed activity ideas and we made a list. Each week we will vote for an idea, the most votes will win. This week the children voted for games and we played different games during the afternoon. This promoted our waiting skills, taking turns and listening.

Homework; Please get your child to practice taking their coat on and off if they can't already, thank you. It just really helps at playtime. It's mainly tackling pulling the arms the right way when they are inside out.
