The children have been playing lots of sound games and listening to different rhymes. We have been name writing every day and the children have made super progress this term. Well done everyone!

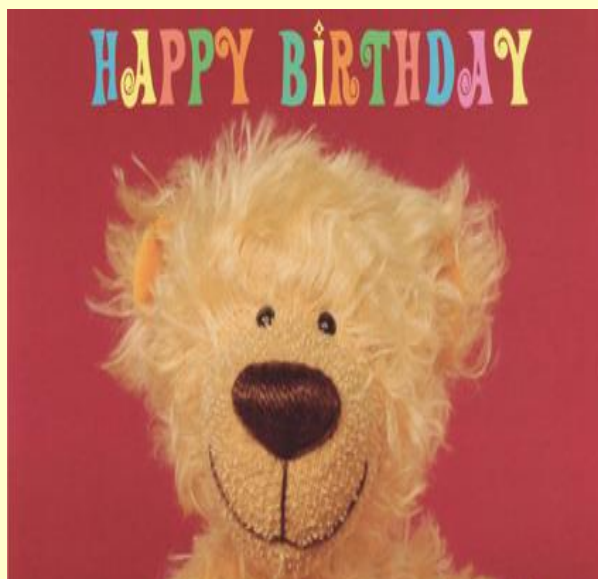


Brighton line number 9

Books of the Week

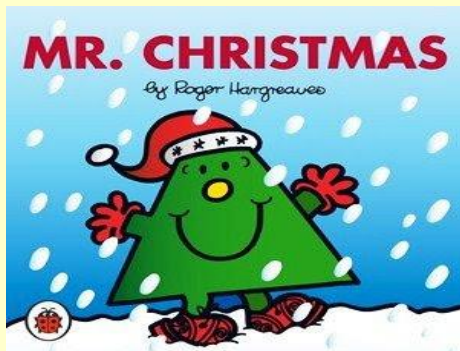
This week we have read many books linked to birthdays.
