Maths:

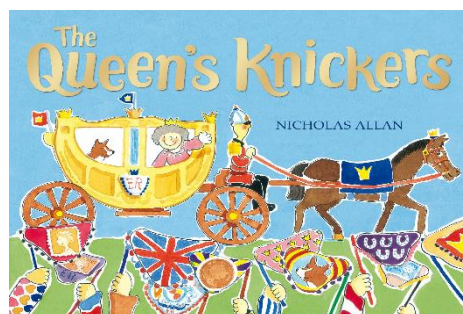
In Maths we have been learning about different types of patterns, completing a pattern activity about the queen.
